popular television personality, she has covered the most recent summer and winter Olympics on behalf of NBC and was the host of the 2017 BET Awards.

Jones also starred in Paul Feig's reboot of *Ghostbusters*, alongside Melissa McCarthy, Kristen Wiig, and Kate McKinnon. Her other film credits include Chris Rock's *Top Five*, Judd Apatow's *Trainwreck*, and the animated film *Sing*. This summer, she will be featured in a lead voice role in *The Angry Birds Movie 2* for Sony Pictures. Jones' opening guest for the evening is comedian Lenny Marcus.
