An expert across various fields, *Time Magazine* recognized Deepak Chopra as "one of the top 100 heroes and icons of the century and the poet-prophet of alternative medicine."

Deepak Chopra, MD, FACP, is the founder of The Chopra Foundation and co-founder of The Chopra Center for Wellbeing. He is Board Certified in Internal Medicine, Endocrinology and Metabolism, is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians, and a member of the American Association of Clinical Endocrinologists.

Chopra is the author of more than 85 books, 25 of which are *The New York Times* bestsellers including *You are the Universe: Discovering Your Cosmic Self and Why it Matters; Super Brain: Unleashing the Explosive Power of your Mind to Maximize Health, Happiness, and Spiritual Well Being; War of the Worldviews;* and *What Are You Hungry For: The Chopra Solution to Permanent Weight Loss, Well-Being and Lightness of the Soul.* A global force in the field of human empowerment, Chopra's books have been published in more than 43 languages. His publications have received a staggering amount of awards including the Religion and Spirituality Quill Award, the Grand Prize in the 2005 Nautilus Awards, and a mention on *Wall Street Journal's* "top five best business books to read for your career."

Chopra's popularity as an international presenter and keynote speaker is exemplified in an impressive list of honorariums. *The World Post* and *The Huffington Post* global Internet survey ranked him the #17 influential thinker in the world and #1 in Medicine.
