ICONIC MUSICIAN JOAN BAEZ BRINGS FARE THEE WELL TOUR, HER FINAL FORMAL NORTH AMERICAN TOUR, TO KIMMEL CENTER CULTURAL CAMPUS SEPTEMBER 26, 2018

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (Philadelphia, PA, July 30, 2018) – The Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts, in association with Larry Magid Entertainment, welcomes back acclaimed artist and activist **Joan Baez**, as she embarks on her final North American tour. The extensive run of shows, following 50 UK and European dates, marks Baez's last year of formal touring and includes a stop at the Kimmel Center's **Verizon Hall** on **Wednesday, September 26, 2018** at **8:00 p.m.** The Telegraph called her performance at London's Royal Albert Hall, "a rapturous evening with a legend." GQ magazine reviewed the performance and said, "The fighter still remains."

"It is always an honor to have the incomparable, world-renowned Joan Baez perform on the Kimmel Center Cultural Campus," said Ed Cambron, Executive Vice President of the Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts. "Baez is not only an incredible musician, but a passionate activist, and Philadelphia audiences are lucky to see her live on her final North American tour."

As a special offer to fans purchasing tickets for Baez's U.S. tour, a CD or digital download of her forthcoming album, *Whistle Down The Wind*, is included with every ticket purchased.

Recorded over a 10-day period in L.A., Whistle Down The Wind was produced by three-time Grammy® Award winner Joe Henry (Bonnie Raitt, Allen Toussaint, and others) and includes songs written by Tom

Waits, Anohni, Mary Chapin Carpenter, Josh Ritter, Eliza Gilkyson, and more. The new music marks the first release from Baez since 2008's Grammy® nominated album, Day After Tomorrow.

Baez remains a musical force of incalculable influence. She marched on the front line of the civil rights movement with Martin Luther King, Jr.; shined a spotlight on the Free Speech Movement; took to the fields with Cesar Chavez; organized resistance to the Vietnam War; inspired Vaclav Havel in his fight for a Czech Republic; saluted the Dixie Chicks for their courage to protest the Iraq war; stood with old friend Nelson Mandela in London's Hyde Park as the world celebrated his 90th birthday; and, most recently, protested the construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline at Standing Rock Sioux Reservation. To this day, she continues to stand passionately on behalf of causes she embraces.

Other featured upcoming performances at the Kimmel Center Cultural Campus include: **Pat Matheny** (October 5, 2018, Merriam Theater), and **AC2: Anderson Cooper and Andy Cohen** (November 3, 2018, Academy of Music).
