Amanda Seales is a comedian and creative visionary with a Master's in African American studies from Columbia University. Seamlessly blending humor and intellect, her unique style of smart funny content spans various genres across the entertainment and multi-media landscape. She is best known for her iconic role as Tiffany DuBois in HBO's *Insecure*; her debut stand-up comedy special, *I Be Knowin*; as a former cohost on daytime talk show, *The Real*; host of NBC's *Bring the Funny*; and the host/writer of the groundbreaking 2020 BET Awards. She speaks truth to change via her wildly popular Instagram, weekly podcast *Small Doses*, and book by the same name.

Centering community building in her comedy, she is also the creator/host of the touring variety game show, *Smart Funny & Black* and of *Smart Funny & Black Radio* on Kevin Hart's LOL Network on SiriusXM. Always an advocate for Black voices, she founded Smart Funny & Black Productions to produce and create art as edutainment across the media landscape by any joke necessary.
